



## SIJRA Code of Conduct and Rule Agreement

The Southern Indiana Junior Rodeo Association (SIJRA) promotes the building of character and sportsmanship in our young cowboys and cowgirls. Responsibility, cooperation, good conduct, and positive attitudes are a life skill that our children develop, enabling them to become upstanding and productive members of their communities.

The following are the terms under which membership of SIJRA must follow. All members, and associates of members, must adhere to these rules. Breaking of any SIJRA General Rules and Regulations (found on pages 7-12 of our rulebook) by members, and/or family/friends of members, could result in your back number being pulled and missing a rodeo event or entire rodeo.

Below are the rules we are emphasizing this year:

- No fighting or rough play allowed.
- No horses around concession stand and other buildings.
- Makeup arena is for warming up and cooling down horses only.
  - Only parents/guardians of members should be in the makeup arena on foot.
- Do not cross over exterior fences.
- No more than two people on an animal at any given time.
- Do not tie animals to trees, buildings, or exterior fences.
