

KINDERGARTEN - 8th Grade CHECKLIST

The following forms need to be turned in before your first rodeo:	
Membership form along with \$40 membership fee	
Accident Waiver & Release of Liability Form/ Code of Conduct	
Sponsorship Brochure: Sponsor Information and minimum \$100 Sponsorship Fee <i>by rodeo</i> . (This will allow you to rodeo for points and be eligible for year-end aw Additional sponsorship awards will also be given at year end.	-

Each rodeo has an online entry form. This must be submitted online before entries close (each rodeo will have a date and time listed in which the entries will close.) Refunds of entry fees will only be given if you draw out 5 days before the rodeo. After that date, it will take a signed Doctor or Veterinarian's statement to receive a refund.

A contestant must check in at the Announcer's Stand the night before (between 7 – 8 pm) or the morning of the rodeo before 8:00 a.m. If you have signed up for a rodeo and cannot make it, you must notify the Rodeo Secretary or Rodeo President - (contact information located on the website & Emergency Response Plan) BEFORE 8:00 a.m. rodeo day. The Contestant must pay the sponsorship fee by their third rodeo in order to be eligible to accumulate points for awards at the end of the year and for voting rights. Please review the Emergency Response Plan in the event of severe weather. The association meeting minutes are posted on the website. We encourage all of the members to review those to keep current on SIJRA. Thank you for being here!

You will receive a laminated back number at your first check-in. It is required for each Member to wear their back numbers at all times, especially when competing. Full western attire will be expected while a Member is competing. Long sleeve western shirts, cowboy hats or helmet and boots. This is not required for Pre-K, however it is encouraged. Volunteers or parent helpers in the Arena are encouraged to wear western attire as well but not mandatory.

Sponsorships of \$100/Member with a maximum of \$200 per family (families of 2 or more) are due by your second rodeo weekend. Sponsorship forms are in your folders or available in the drawers outside of the Announcer's Stand. Each member that turns in a minimum of \$100 in sponsorship will receive a membership award at the end of the year.

Times will be posted throughout the day at the Announcer's Stand. Let us know if you find any mistakes ASAP. Once the event results are posted at the table, your awards can be picked up at the award's table. The colored cups are participation cups and you can pick up a cup for each event you participated in. First place event winners may pick up a trophy and blue cup, second place receives a red cup and third place receives a yellow cup.
