### **Southern Indiana Junior Rodeo Arena – 8:45**

Grand Entry - ALL kids are welcome to ride their horse in the Grand Entry. Each age division will be led in by their Queen/Princess. Pre-K will have their Grand Entry on foot/stick horse during the K-8 Grand Entry.

You will receive a laminated back number at your first check-in. It is required for each Member to wear their back numbers at all times, especially when competing. Full western attire will be expected while a Member is competing. Long sleeve western shirts, cowboy hats or helmet and boots. This is not required for Pre-K, however it is encouraged. Volunteers or parent helpers in the Arena are encouraged to wear western attire as well but not mandatory.

Sponsorships of \$100/Member with a maximum of \$200 per family (families of 2 or more) are due by your second rodeo weekend. Sponsorship forms are in your folders or available in the drawers outside of the Announcer's Stand. Each member that turns in a minimum of \$100 in sponsorship will receive a membership award at the end of the year.

Times will be posted throughout the day at the Announcer's Stand. Let us know if you find any mistakes ASAP. Once the event results are posted at the table, your awards can be picked up at the award's table. The colored cups are participation cups and you can pick up a cup for each event you participated in. First place event winners may pick up a trophy and blue cup, second place receives a red cup and third place receives a yellow cup.
